**Document Number: AC 1.1 Academic Initiatives Committee**

## 1.0 Scope

This policy outlines the Society's Academic Initiatives Committee.

## 2.0 Responsibilities

- 2.1 The Board of Directors has oversight responsibility for this policy.
- 2.2 The Committee has the responsibility to implement the policy.
- 2.3 The Academic Initiatives Committee manages the Society's processes for interacting with academic institutions, their faculties, and their students.
- 2.4 The Committee works closely with both the Statistical Engineering Handbook and the Body of Knowledge (BoK) Committees.

## 3.0 Specifications

- 3.1 The Chair of the Committee does not have to be a member of the Board of the Directors.
- 3.2 The Committee Chair determines the number of members and has primary responsibility to recruit them.
- 3.3 The representatives from the academic institutions that are organizational members form a required subcommittee. This sub-committee must meet on a regular basis:
  - 3.3.1 To discuss academic issues within the statistical engineering discipline.
  - 3.3.2 To foster co-operation across the academic institutions to advance statistical engineering.
  - 3.3.3 To provide advice to the Society leadership on how to address the needs of academic institutions better.
- 3.4 The Committee may operate through other subcommittees at its own discretion.
- 3.5 The Committee recommends norms for statistical engineering curricula, including capstone experiences.
- 3.6 The Committee works with non-academic organizational members
  - 3.6.1 To provide opportunities for capstone experiences
  - 3.6.2 To facilitate opportunities for faculty to work within non-academic organizations and for non-academic practitioners to work within universities.
  - 3.6.3 To facilitate non-academic institutional support for academic faculty research, especially in the theory of statistical engineering.

- 3.7 As appropriate, the Committee works with funding agencies to support academic initiatives in statistical engineering.
